

Brian Duchin is President of the Greater San Antonio Camera Club(GSACC) and has been actively involved in digital and film photography since the 1960s.

Brian recalls, “I picked up a Kodak Brownie camera when I was 12 and shot a roll of film with it. My cousin showed me how to develop the film and make prints. I found it magical the first time I watched a piece of white paper become a print. I was hooked on photography.” He added, “In high school I was the school’s newspaper sport’s editor and photographer. After college graduation I was a newspaper reporter and photographer. I also managed a national photofinishing lab. So photography has always been in my blood.”

Brian successfully completed the course “Image Analysis and Judging Competition Prints” presented by the Photographic Society of America. He served on the committee which developed GSACC’s criteria for judging print and digital competition images.

He received numerous awards for his entries in the 2016 San Antonio Photo Tournament sponsored by Photo SA Meetup Camera Club. In 2016 GSACC awarded Brian Photographer of the Year third place.
